In 2001, she came back to Korea and continued her choreographic and performance practice revisiting classics of her country or investigating social issues - often working with non-professionals. With over 150 pieces in her repertoire, she has know an international recognition with emblematic productions such as *Symphoca Princess Bari, Let Me Change Your Name* or *Dancing Grandmothers*» that have been presented on the most prestigious stages around the world. Eun-Me Ahn is associated artist to Théâtre de la Ville - Paris.
